<b>How was this project identified?</b> (e.g. how do you know there is a need?)	Our estate is geographically isolated from mainstream activities and many young people from low income families miss out due to lack of funds to be able to travel to council sponsored events. Our survey, done by young people with young people last summer, showed that, of the 54 people asked, 49 of them would welcome some organised activity on the estate in the holidays. At our last meeting a small group attended to ask if we could help them with a graffiti wall.

<b>What exactly do you propose to do?</b>	Provide a daily workshop for 5 days – 3 hours per day
